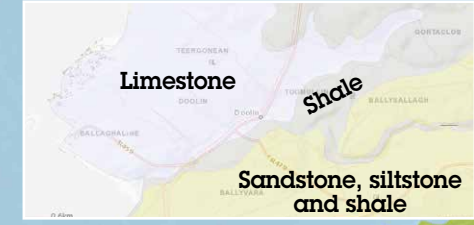

1 Aolchloch agus Sceall i dTeagmháil Tá Dúlainn suite ar phointe tábhachtach teagmhála geolaíche idir an aolchloch mhaol atá le feiceáil ó thuaidh agus an sceall dorchá a shíneann ó dheas go Lios Dúin Bhearna.

Limestone –Shale contact
Doolin is located on an important geological contact between the bare limestone which is exposed to the north and the dark shale which stretches to Lisdoonvarna.



2 Caisleán Dhún Mhic Fheidhlim Fothrach túrthí a thóg muintir Uí Chonchubhair thart ar 1500. Bhíodh ceithre urlár san iomlán sa túrtheach ach leag arm Chromail é. Tabhair faoi deara: I seilbh phriobháideach, níl cead isteach ag an bpobal.

Doonmacfelim Castle The remains of a tower house built by the O'Connor clan around 1500. Originally four stories high, it was demolished by Cromwell's army.
Note: Private property, no public access.



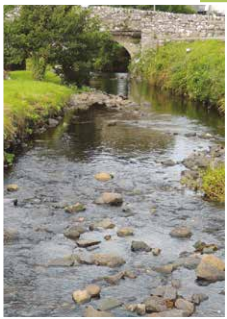
3 Ráth Chnoc an Stualaire Faigheann an ráth seo lena radharc anuas ar Dhúlainn, a ainm ón stualaire, nó gallán, atá suite ann. Tabhair faoi deara: I seilbh phriobháideach, níl cead isteach ag an bpobal.

Cnoc Na Stualaire Earth Fort The fort with its standing stone overlooking Doolin derives its name from the Irish "stualaire", meaning a peak or a point.
Note: Private property, no public access.



4 Abhainn na hAille Ritheann Abhainn na hAille trí chraosán caol ó Lios Dúin Bhearna go Dúlainn. Leanann an abhainn rian na teagmhála geolaíche idir an sceall agus an aolchloch agus rachaidh sí thíos faoin talamh in imeacht ama.

Aille River The Aille River flows through a narrow gorge from Lisdoonvarna to Doolin. The river flows along the geological contact between shale and limestone and will eventually go underground.



5 Mianaigh Fosáite an Bhreithimh Comyn Áit a mbíodh mianaigh fosáite le linn an Dara Cogadh Domhanda. Cruthaíodh an fhosáite sa sceall mar thoradh ar chnámha éisc a bheith á gcarmadh breis is 300 milliún bliain ó shin. I seilbh phriobháideach, níl cead isteach ag an bpobal.

Judge Comyn's Phosphate Mines Site of phosphate mines during the Second World War. The phosphate formed in shale from the accumulation of fish bones over 300 million years ago.
Note: Private property, no public access.



6 Séipéal Thuaim Molinne Fothrach séipéal ón 15ú haois agus láthair a mbíodh séipéal ón 14ú haois ann. I seilbh phriobháideach, níl cead isteach ag an bpobal.

Toomullin Church Remains of a 15th Century church and site of an earlier 14th Century church.
Note: Private property, no public access.



8 Phluaiseanna Thíos faoi bhaile Dhúlainn tá 10 gcliméadar de phluaiseanna a shíneann ón séipéal go dtí an fharraige. Cruthaíodh iad na mílte bliain ó shin mar thoradh ar uisce a bheith ag rith tríd an aolchloch.

Caves Below Doolin are 10km of cave passages that stretch from the church to the sea. They began to form over a hundred thousand years ago as water flowed through cracks in the limestone.



7 Cnocán an Chrochaire Ráth. Mharaigh an tArd-Sirriam Boetius Mac Fhlannchadha mairmeálaigh ó Armáid na Spáinne a tháinig slán ó longbhriseadh agus déirtear gur anseo a cuireadh iad in 1588. I seilbh phriobháideach, níl cead isteach ag an bpobal.

Cnocan An Chrochaire An earthen ring fort. Sailors from the Spanish Armada who survived a shipwreck were killed by High Sheriff Boetius MacClancy and supposedly buried here in 1588.
Note: Private property, no public access



10 Séipéal Chill Aidhleach Séipéal ón 10ú – 17ú haois, a ndearnadh athchóiriú ar chuid de faoin tionscnamh pobail 'Sábháil Séipéal Chill Aidhleach'.

Killilagh Church A 10th – 17th Century church, parts of which have been restored by a local community initiative 'Save Killilagh Church Project'.



9 Ionad Cultúrtha Uí Ruiséil Ionad pobail a tógadh mar chomórath ar dheartháireacha Uí Ruiséil, ar cheoltóirí áitiúla traidisiúnta iad a bhain cáil amach ar fud an domhain. Tá an ceol traidisiúnta fós an-láidir sa cheantar.

Russell Cultural Centre Community centre built in honour of the Russell brothers who were world famous local traditional musicians. Traditional music is still very much alive in the area.



11 Teach Dhúlainn Níl mórán fágtha de theach Ard-Sirriam an Chláir a dódh go talamh in 1921 le linn Chogadh na Saoirse.

Doolin House Little remains of the home of the High Sheriff of Clare which was burnt to the ground in 1921 during the War of Independence.

- NÁ FÁG AON LORG I DO DHIAIDH**
- Déantar Pleanáil agus Ullmhúchán Roimh Ré Bíodh an trealamh cuí agat don tsiúlóid chomh maith le trealamh a bheadh cabhrach i gcás éigeandála. Seiceáil ar réamhaisnéis na haimsire agus bí ullamh i gcónaí roimh athruithe aimsire.
 - Bítear Aireach mar Gheall ar Dhaoine Eile Déan páirceáil mar is cuí, ná cuir bac ar bhealaigh isteach. Ná déan aon damáiste do mhaoín, go háirithe do bhallaí, d'fhálta nó do bharra.
 - Bíodh Meas ar Ainmhithe Feirme agus ar an bhFiadhúlra Coimnítear achar sábháilte amach ó ainmhithe feirme. Ná tóg madraí leat ar thalamh feirme. Breathnaigh ar an bhfiadhúlra agus ar éin agus tú i bhfad uathu—gan a bheith ag cur isteach orthu.
 - An Bealach a Chosaint ó Chreimeadh Bí ag taisteal i ngrúpaí beaga agus siúltar duine i ndiaidh duine ar aon chuid den bhealach atá fliuch nó creimthe.
 - Fágtar a bhFhaightear Fágtar geataí mar a fhaightear iad (oscailte nó dúnta). Fágtar clocha, plandaí, ainmhithe, gnáthoga agus séadchomharthaí mar a fhaightear iad.
 - Déantar Diúscairt mar is Cóir ar Dhramháil. Tóg abhaile GACH bruscar agus fuilleach bia – Má Thógann tú Ann É – Tóg Leat Amach É!
 - Laghdaítear Tionchar Tine Ná las tinte agus má chaitheann tú tobac bíodh cipíní caite agus bunanna toitin tógtha abhaile leat.
 - Fágtar an Phábháil Aolchloiche mar a Fhaightear i Tá an phábháil aolchloiche faoi chosaint dlí agus i liostaithe mar "Gnáthóg Tosaíochta" faoin Treoir maidir le Gnáthoga ón Aontas Eorpach, 1992.
- LEAVE NO TRACE ON THE TRAIL**
- Plan Ahead and Prepare Ensure you have the equipment needed for your walk and to cope with emergencies that could arise. Check the weather forecast and always be prepared for changing weather conditions.
 - Be Considerate of Other People Park appropriately so that entrances are not blocked. Do not to damage property, especially walls, fences and crops..
 - Respect Farm Animals and Wildlife Remain at a safe distance from farm animals. Do not bring dogs through farmland. Observe wild animals and birds from a distance—avoid disturbing them.
 - Protect the Trail from Erosion Travel in small groups and walk in single file on wet or eroded sections.
 - Leave what you find Leave gates as you find them (open or closed). Leave rocks, plants, animals, habitats and monuments as you find them.
 - Dispose of Waste Properly. Take home ALL litter and leftover food – if you Bring It In – Take It Out!
 - Minimise the Effects of Fire Do not light fires and if you smoke, take used matches and cigarette butts home with you.
 - Leave the Limestone Pavement as you find it Limestone pavement is listed as a "Priority Habitat" in the European Habitats Directive 1992, and is protected by law.
